## 2024 Income and Asset Guidelines

To be eligible for financial assistance from The University of Vermont Health Network, VT Hospitals, your assets, and annual income should be at or below the guidelines shown below. Some items such as your primary residence and non-recreational vehicles are not considered assets for this purpose. If your income and/or assets is more than the guidelines, but you have extenuating circumstances, your application may be considered. Please include a letter explaining your extenuating circumstances.

You must be a resident within The University of Vermont Health Network service areas: All of Vermont and Clinton, Essex, Franklin, Washington, Hamilton, Warren, and St. Lawrence Counties of New York and for laboratory services only, selective counties within New Hampshire.

The University of Vermont Health Network is committed to providing the appropriate level of assistance to the greatest number of persons in need. To do this The University of Vermont Medical Center has implemented a policy with guidelines to financial aid based upon a sliding fee scale. Balances after the financial assistance percentage have been applied will be the responsibility of the patient and should be paid promptly.
